1. Brahma Sutras ब्रह्मसूत्रः:

‘Brahma Sutras ‘ब्रह्मसूत्रः’ glimpsed and organized by Maharishi Krishna-dvipayana कृष्णद्वैपायन (Vyasa व्यास) start unfolding:

‘अथातो ब्रह्मजिज्ञासा ।’
Athato Brahmajijnasa





4. Sathapatya format of organization

- i. Number value 4 is of Sathapatya format of 4-space
- ii. Number value $4 \times 4 = 16$ is of Sathapatya format of quadruple spatial dimensions frame (2^4) of 4-space
- iii. Values quadruple (31, 32, 42, 28) of summation value 134 of chapter 1 is of Sathapatya format features :-

$$31 = h8, 32 = D10, 42 = H11, 28 = D9 \text{ and } 134 = H34$$

These Sathapatya features permit chase in terms of 8 dimensional frame




$$31 = 9 + 22; M_1E$$

$$28 = 12 + 16 = M_4C$$







$$52 = 22 + 30 : EB$$







5. Brahma-nirvāṇam ब्रह्मनिर्वाण


Sankhiya Yog (Geeta Chapter 2.72) preserve the enlightenment as that Sankhiya Nishtha reach is into the kingdom of God,

एषा ब्राह्मी स्थितिः पार्थ नैनां प्राप्य विमुद्यति ।
स्थित्वास्यामन्तकालेऽपि ब्रह्मनिर्वाणमुच्छति ॥(2.72)

*esā brāhmī sthitih pārtha
nainām prāpya vimuhyati
sthitvāsyām anta-kāle 'pi
brahma-nirvānam rcchati (2.72)*

Sathapatya of formulation ब्रह्मनिर्वाण Brahma-nirvāṇam

TCV (ब्रह्म) = 28, TCV (निर्वाण) = 29 = TCV (ब्रह्मा / presiding deity of creator (4-space) space. $28 + 29 = 57 = 3 \times 19$;



(दिव्य जन्म / Divya Janam / Spiritual Birth = $17 + 23$) = 40.

(Brahma / ब्रह्मा to Braham / ब्रह्म reach feature Sarvamb Prityagi सर्वम् भ परित्यागी) / fluctuating ‘middle / मध्य,

TCV (सर्व आरम्भ परित्यागी) = $14 + 24 + 29 + 25 = 67 = 68 - 1 = 57 + 10$; 01, 10) constitutes, a first reflection pair of double digits number of ten place value system

Note :- Let us revisit the text of Ganita Sutra 2 and its format Sathapatya.

Ganita Sutra 2 text


निखिलं नवतश्चरमं दशतः:

all from 9 and last from ten

TCV (निखिलं) = 29 = TCV (ब्रह्मा)

TCV (नवतश्चरमं) = 50 = (एकोविंशति); (एकोविंशति) = 19 = TCV (मध्य)

TCV (दशतः) = 28 = TCV (ब्रह्म)



29 points range is of 29 units

10 points range is of 9 units

TCV (मध्य middle) = 19 = एकोविंशति

TCV (एकोविंशति) = 50

Fluctuating middle of value $14 \frac{1}{2}$ of 29 points range and of value 14 of 28 units range.

$$\text{TCV (ब्रह्म)} = 28, 28 / 2 = 14, \text{TCV (ब्रह्मा)} = 29, 29 / 2 = 14.5$$
