

Artifices of numbers and dimensional frames

- 1. Vedic Systems work out artifices of numbers and dimensional frames parallel to each other
- 2. Two established procees () of Vedic Systems are Sankhiya Nishtha and Yoga Nishtha.
- 3. Sankhiya Nishtha presumes the existence of geometric formats and avails artifices of numbers.
- 4. On the other hand Yoga Nishtha presumes the existence of artifices of numbers and works out Existence Phenomenon within dimensional frames.
- 5. Sankhiya Nishtha and Yoga Nishtha not only run parallel to each other but also they complement and supplement at processing steps.
- 6. The expectations from 10 + 2 class passouts would be that they comprehend well and thoroughly appreciate the parallel features of

- artifices of numbers and dimensional frames.
- 7. It is further expected that from 10 + 2 class passout that they can process out dimensional frames along artifices of numbers and vice versa.
- 8. It is this feature of the mental state of Mathematics students which shall be making them a class amongst the whole range of students.
- The focus of school Mathematics, as such, naturally is to be properly teach Mathematics which helps students to acquire requisite mental state to handle artifices of numbers and dimensional frames parallel to each other.
