**Sathapatya (geometric format)  
of Text of Vishnu Puran**

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**Abstract**

Vishnu (विष्णु) is presiding deity of 6-space Text of Vishnu Puran is organized along Sathapatya base of Hyper Cube-6, the representative regular body of 6-space. Surya (सूर्य / Sun) and Manav Shareer (मानव शरीर / Human body) are manifestations of 6-space content Vishnu Puran chases the parallel features of existence phenomenon of solar universe and of existence within human frame. Sathapatya measuring rod, a synthetic set up of Hyper cubes 1 to 6 the representative regular bodies of 1 to 6 space and artifices of numbers as organized along 10 place value systems of Sathapatya base of creative boundary of 10 components of transcendental (5-space) are being availed.

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**1. Text of Vishnu Puran**

Of 18 Puranas, Vishnu Puran is of the placement following Braham and Padam, first 2 Puranas. Vishnu Puran text, as has reached us and is published by Geeta Press, Gorakpur as publication no 48, is organized as 6 Ansh and of 126 Chapters & 6463 Shalokas.

**2. Hyper Cube 6**

Hyper Cube 6 is the representative regular body of 6-space and 6-space domain accepts Sathapatya measuring rod being the synthetic set up of Hyper Cubes 1 to 6.

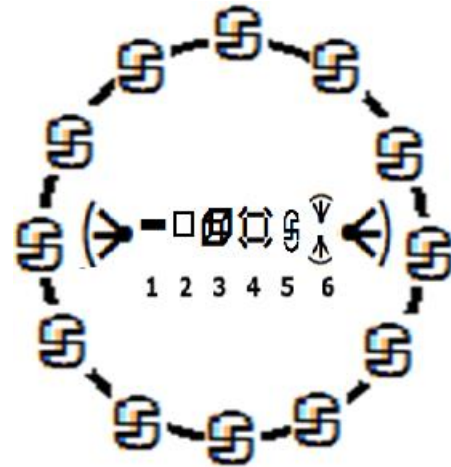


The organization feature of text as of 6 Ansh is parallel with 6 dimensions of 6-space. The organization feature of the text as of 126 chapters is parallel with the set up of 6 dimensions, each of Sathapatya format of 6-space measuring rod :

$$= 6 \times (1 + 2 + 3 + 4 + 5 + 6)$$

The organization feature of text being of 6463 shalokas is of set up of 6000 + 463. The value 6000 = 6 x 1000 = 6 x 10<sup>3</sup>; 6 = षट् Shat; TCV (षट्) = 10; 6 = 1 + 2 + 3, 10 = 1 + 2 + 3 + 4. Hyper Cube 6 is a set up of 6-space domain of creative (4-space) order and is of transcendental (5-space) body of solid (3-space) order.

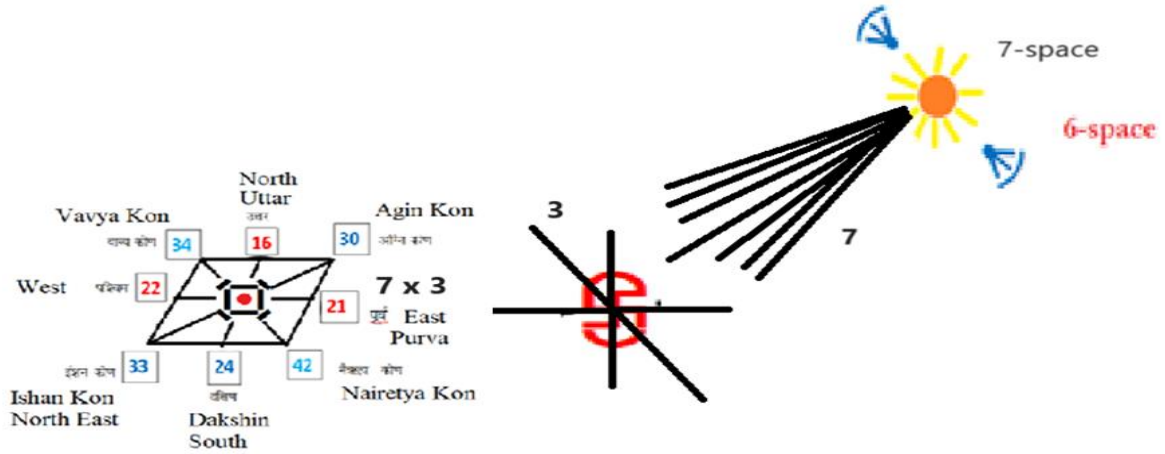
